Slicing and grating of hard cheeses (made from raw milk) and semi-hard cheeses packaged in plastic bags for industrial customers. Production of cheese preparations packaged in plastic film. Production of pasteurized ready-made fondue, packed partly under vacuum in aluminum composite bags, PET cups and plastic buckets. Production of pasteurised processed cheese, packed in aluminum, aluminum composite and composite foil and plastic wrapper. Production of cream and whey concentrate in bulk.
